You will also be able to walk your ballot into the community center between 9:30 -10:00 the morning of the election before the meeting is called to order. The meeting will be in the community center on April 29<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM. Be sure to follow the instructions in the mailing with your ballot. Be sure to sign the outer envelope or your ballot will not be counted.

Always have your member ID with you on association property. Each property is issued four guest cards. On Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and at association events guests must be accompanied by a member. Guest cards have a blue banner at the bottom of the card. Member ID cards with your picture has a green band at the bottom of the card. Members may also request 6 one day passed four times a year. For larger groups, members can schedule an event. This is for the beach, parks, or event rooms. There are requirements. Contact the association office for details.
