Just a reminder: You will find all staff from the association office relocated to the Community Center on Rolling Ridge while the association office is being repaired and remodeled.

Boat Registrations will begin November 1st. Just a reminder that your California Boaters License will be required. Boat slip renewal for the year is November 1st.

Admin staff are calling all owners to verify their contact information. You will also be asked if you would like to opt out of having your information given out on the member list to other members. Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts. Any change to your Grant Deed needs to be submitted to the association for any changes to your account.

Always have your member ID with you on association property. Anyone 9 years of age and older must have a member card or guest card on association property. Each property is issued four guest cards. On Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and at association events guests must be accompanied by a member. Members may also request 6 one day passes four times a year. For larger groups, members can schedule an event. This is for the beach, parks or event rooms. There are requirements. Contact the association office for details. Guest cards have a blue banner at the bottom of the card. Member ID cards with your picture has a green band on the card.

Tenants must apply and be approved for membership. It is time to apply again for the new fiscal year. This membership is valid November 1 through October 31 each year. Tenants must apply each year to renew.

Stay informed. Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association face-book page, the Breeze and bulletin boards throughout the community.
