The Election Meeting is this Saturday, April 27, 2024. Ballots will be received by the Inspectors of Election on Saturday between 9:30 am to 10:00 am.

If you need a replacement ballot, there will be some available from the Inspectors of Election on Saturday.

Committee assignments end May 32, 2024. Committee members are needed. Applications are available on the website. Applications must be submitted by May 10, 2024, to be included on the May Board Meeting agenda.

Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts. Any change to your Grant Deed needs to be submitted to the association for any changes to your account.
