

A Message from the Public Safety Department

We are in full swing of days that are above 100-degrees. Our Public Safety department wants to remind Members to stay cool and hydrated to prevent heat exhaustion, or worse, heat stroke.

Both heat exhaustion and heat stroke occur when the body becomes overheated and cannot cool itself.

Symptoms include:

- General Weakness
- Increased Sweating
- Pale, Clammy Skin
- Possible Fainting or Lightheadedness

If you begin experiencing symptoms, first try to find a cooler location and, if possible, remove a layer of clothing. Drink plenty of cold water and lie down.


If you begin vomiting or lose consciousness, seek professional medical attention immediately. **Heat stroke is considered a medical emergency, do not hesitate to dial 911.**
