The lake level is quickly approaching normal level. We are currently approximately 15" away from being full. The lake is scheduled to open on April 23, 2023 with a no wake in effect and then will be fully open with no restrictions on May 1, 2023. We are very excited to see everyone back out enjoying the open water, just as the weather begins to warm up.

We have been doing our best to continue with the lake clean up as the water continues to rise. If you notice any areas with excessive trash or debris, it is always helpful to let us know. Give the office a call or send an email <u>maintenance@svla.com</u>.

We have also acquired a lake consultant to come out and do a complete assessment of the lake. We are aiming to get to the core of the problem, with the coving damage and to see what our options are for repairs and for preventing additional damage in the future. This consultant will provide us with their findings and give recommendations as to how we can improve the integrity of our lake, moving forward. We are looking forward to seeing the results of the study within the next month or so.

Administration & Lake Management

The existing docks, that have been housed in the middle of the lake for the duration of the lake lowering, were moved back to the Marina on April 21, 2023 and are being inspected for repairs. The two slips that are being replaced were taken to east beach, where we had a crew demo and dispose of them.

Phase 1 of the dock replacement is also underway. Our vendor is scheduled to have all the frames and flotations delivered onsite from April 24, 2023 -April 28, 2023. They will then begin assembling and installing the new docks in the water beginning May 1, 2023. It will take them approximately 4 weeks to complete. You will see a lot of activity in the marina during this time. Additionally, all the items will be stored in the Association Parking lot as they are assembling and installing, so please be aware that the parking spaces to the west of the Association office, on the north side, will be inaccessible. If you are interested in renting a slip, contact the Association Office to find out what the process is, as we expect them to fill, rather quickly.
