Our biggest project that we are currently focusing on is the coving repairs and we are moving along. Look below to see all that has been happening around the community....

Beach Areas

- Sanitizing picnic tables and playground equipment daily

Administration & Lake Management We are toward the end of our coving repairs and looking to wrap it up in the next couple of weeks. Our contractors have all 20 lots fully formed with rebar grid and ready for concrete to be poured. 5 lots of the 17 are fully completed as well as the work on Fishing area #7 and the 3 adjacent lots. Additionally, our Maintenance team has completed 10 lots. We are still looking to be on track for our March 1, 2023 completion date.

Given that we stay on track with completion, we are projecting to begin raising the level of the lake on March 2, 2023. We will begin raising the lake approximately 1" per day and it will take approximately 90 days for it to reach full level.

In addition to the coving work that is being done, we have another crew of employees going around and removing trash and debris from the shoreline. We are also taking photos and video of every lake front property to have on file, as a complete assessment of the coving. As you can see, there is a lot of activity out there.

Phase 1 of the dock replacement is also underway, as our vendor has ordered supplies and has begun building the frames. Once all the frames are built you will then see the frames and floatation devices being delivered to the marina and they will begin assembling. We are expecting to see the assembling and installation process begin early spring.
