Happy New Year! It's crazy to think we are already at the beginning of a new year. With a new year comes new projects and challenges and we are ready to tackle them all.

We have been working with CSA-64 on obtaining access to a sewer hookup, to dispose of the water from our UV filter cleaning. Once we have this access, we can resume our filter cleaning, bi-weekly, and replace the new UV bulbs to get them up and running back to their normal capacity.

We are still waiting for the permit to be issued for the Lake Patrol Office (LPO). We have been contacting the county weekly for updates on this permit. We just made payment for the required fees, so we are hoping to have the permit issued soon. Once the permit is issued, the contractor estimates it will be completed within 2 weeks.

We have already received 4 deliveries of Trout and still have two more scheduled. We have loved seeing the fishermen around the community show casing their catches. This is a great time to cast your lines as the lake is being freshly stocked.
