Administration & Lake Management

The lake level is quickly approaching normal level. We are currently approximately 6" away from being full. The lake opened on April 23, 2023 with a no wake in effect and fully opened with no restrictions on May 1, 2023. We are very excited to see everyone back out enjoying the open water, just as the weather begins to warm up.

We have been doing our best to continue with the lake clean up as the water continues to rise. If you notice any areas with excessive trash or debris, it is always helpful to let us know. Give the office a call or send an email <a href="maintenance@svla.com">maintenance@svla.com</a>.

Our lake consultant is in the final stages of building their report. Once the report is reviewed, we can then begin planning what our next move will be with the lake repairs.

The existing docks, that were housed in the middle of the lake for the duration of the lake lowering, were moved back to the Marina on April 21, 2023 and are in the process of receiving repairs. The two slips that are being replaced were taken to east beach, where we had a crew demo and dispose of them.

Phase 1 of the dock replacement is also underway. One set of slips has been assembled and installed and they are currently working on the second. Once they are assembled and installed then they will be able to run electrical, lay flooring and place all the cleats, rub rails, lights, posts etc. They are estimated to be done around the first week of June. If you are interested in renting a slip, contact the Association Office to find out what the process is, as we expect them to fill rather quickly.
