### Public Safety Director's Monthly Report Board of Directors Regular Meeting

January 22, 2013

- We responded to numerous reports of running water and broken pipes due to the cold weather. Public Safety and Maintenance turned off the water at several residences where no one was home saving many homes from significant damage and costs incurred from running water.
- Sgt. Nathan Bjork and Officer Ray Tongolei found a sheared off fire hydrant at the corner of SVL Pkwy and Santa Anita Trail. They followed a trail of fluid to an abandoned vehicle that was being investigated by the Sheriff's Department. Our officer informed the deputies about the hit and run. The CHP took over the case and located the driver at home who was intoxicated and had left the Marina Lounge. He was arrested for the hit and run and driving under the influence. Our surveillance cameras are going to be critical in the case because the D.A. needs to prove the subject was indeed the driver of the truck.
- Lt. Logan and Cpl. Werner were on routine patrol when they noticed a few dollar bills lying in the street. Upon further investigation, they located almost \$90 in cash and a wallet lying in the street. They were able to return the wallet and all of its contents to a grateful owner.
- I wanted to urge everyone to please fill out the Emergency Contact Sheet that you will be receiving soon. It is absolutely critical in many cases for us to be able to contact someone that is responsible for a residence. In about 40% of the water break cases we handled this week, we were unable to contact anyone.
