Association Staff wants to remind our members of a few things...

With the Firework show approaching, make sure you plan ahead - vessel registration & vessel inspections will not take place, and replacement guest passes will not be issued on that day.

All members must accompany their guests on the day of the Firework show. And all guests must have a physical guest card.

Temperatures outside are rising quickly, always check asphalt prior to allowing your pets to walk on it. Remember if it's too hot for your bare feet then it's too hot for their paws.

Do not feed local wildlife, including ducks and squirrels so they do not become dependent on human interaction. Wild animals carry diseases, the best way to protect yourself and your family is to watch them from afar.

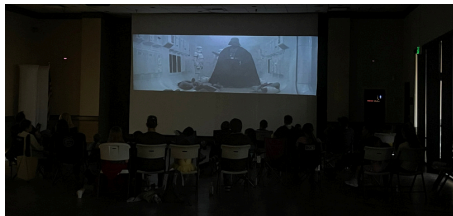

Remodel Updates

You have probably noticed that the Lake Patrol Office is still under construction. We filed our original permits in September 2023; since then, we have been in contact with the county 28 times.

Once the permits are received, the project should be completed in approx. two weeks.

As for the Association Office; work has officially begun. The contractors have completed demolition, the framing, and ground plumbing. They are now preparing to work on the Fascia.

Our hope is to be back in that building by the end of October.

A Message from Code Enforcement

The Architecture Liaison wants to remind SVLA residents to make their architecture appointments on the SVLA Living App.

Make sure you turn in your project applications before beginning work to avoid any citations. All applications need to be submitted at least 9 days before the next architecture committee meeting. The Committee typically meets the second and fourth Thursday of each month.

Yard Sales

To host a yard sale, a permit from Public Safety is required.

Per SVLA Rules and Regulations section 9.5: *Garage/yard sales are limited to four (4) a year, each limited to three (3) days in duration, and a maximum of one (1) in a thirty (30) day period. Any garage/yard sale exceeding the aforementioned restrictions shall be considered to be a business on residential property in violation of the CC&Rs.*
