Association Staff wants to remind our members of a few things...

With the Firework show approaching, make sure you plan ahead - vessel registration & vessel inspections will not take place, and replacement guest passes will not be issued on that day.

All members must accompany their guests on the day of the Firework show. And all guests must have a physical guest card. A Message from Code Enforcement

The Architecture Liaison wants to remind SVLA residents to make their architecture appointments on the SVLA Living App.

Make sure you turn in your project applications <u>before</u> beginning work to avoid any citations. All applications need to be submitted at least 9 days before the next architecture committee meeting. The Committee typically meets the second and fourth Thursday of each month.

Tis the season for weeds! Make sure you keep an eye out for those pesky things.

Yard Sales

To host a yard sale, a permit from Public Safety is required.

Per SVLA Rules and Regulations section 9.5: Garage/yard sales are limited to four (4) a year, each limited to three (3) days in duration, and a maximum of one (1) in a thirty (30) day period. Any garage/yard sale exceeding the aforementioned restrictions shall be considered to be a business on residential property in violation of the CC&Rs.
