

Additional Requirement to Registering a Vessel

Registration of Vessels - Weight Limits

The Lake Committee submitted a Committee Action Item Request (CAIR) to the Board of Directors to add a weight limit to all vessels registered in SVLA. The Board of Directors voted to move forward with the enforcement of the rule. This rule becomes effective immediately due to the severity of the damage to the lake that can be caused from vessels with a larger weight. There is a 30-day comment period.

Any vessel registered with Spring Valley Lake Association (SVLA) is restricted to a weight limit of 7500 pounds. Official manufacturers specifications will be used to determine the weight of the vessel. (Dry published weight plus dry published maximum ballast weight not to exceed 7500 pounds.)

Vessels that have been registered in the 2021 year will be grandfathered in for the 2022 year. Registration of the vessel will no longer qualify at such time the vessel changes title.

Boat length limits remain the same as follows: Pontoon boats 24 feet and all other vessels 22 feet.

Vessel registration for the 2022 year begins December 1, 2021. The following items are required for powered vessel registration:

Current DMV Registration for the 2022-2023 year
Quagga and Zebra Mussel Fee sticker
Current Driver's License
Current Vessel Operator's Permit (VOP) issued by SVLA
Safety Inspection by Public Safety 760-245-6400
Insurance Policy
Signed Conditions Form
